SPEECH OF THE NATIONAL PRESIDENT, NBM OF AFRICA TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT THE IDP CAMP, BORNO STATE ON THE 12TH OF NOVEMBER, 2024

Beloved brothers and sisters, fathers and mothers; I bring you greetings of love and hope from the **Neo Black Movement of Africa**. My name is **Olorogun Ese Kakor (JP)** and the President of the **NBM Of Africa**, also known as the **Neo Black Movement Of Africa Worldwide**; we are here to console you in this time of grief and pains.

The **NBM of Africa** is a **Pan African Organization** duly registered within the laws of Nigeria; we are an organization obliged to engage efforts, provide resources and enforce ideas that are capable of reviving, preserving and protecting African cultures and traditions

The **NBM of Africa** as a Non-Governmental Organization prioritizes humanitarian services as one of its objectives wherever we find ourselves; thus our visit to Borno State.

Between **October 2022** and **January 2023**, the Organization visited **13 States** within **Nigeria** and provided succor to persons that were internally displaced by the flood that ravaged most parts of Nigeria namely:-

The Organization has built classroom blocks for schools, built and renovated police stations, provided scholarships to students in primary, secondary schools and even tertiary institutions. The Organization has also provided free health care services to communities.

My beloved African people, our visit to this Internal Displaced people's camp is not a show off but an act of patriotic service to humanity; we feel your pains and share in your grief, this is why we have come here with these palliatives (**400 tubers of yam, 100 bags of rice and 50 bags of beans**) to help reduce the harsh effects the flood has caused.

My brothers and sisters, fathers and mothers, do not feel you are alone in this; we are together in this and we will visit again with more palliatives to ensure you lack nothing
